Bulldog Fans,

As we are moving closer to winter sports season here at Louisiana, the administration has spent a considerable amount of time devising a plan to allow winter sports to take place here at Louisiana with spectators present, while trying to keep everyone safe. With that being said, we are setting the following guidelines/limitations on basketball games and extra-curricular events that are going to take place on the Louisiana R-2 campus.

- All basketball games and band/choir concerts (middle school and high school) will take place in the High School Gymnasium. This gym is larger and allows for more spectators and social distancing.
- Each Louisiana student and coach/director will be allotted 6 vouchers per home event to hand out to 6 people of their choosing. If a student or coach/director is not going to use some or all of their vouchers, they may give them to another student to hand out.
- Each visiting student and coach will be allotted 4 vouchers per event here at Louisiana to hand out to 4 people of their choosing. If a student or coach is not going to use some or all of their vouchers, they may give them to another student to hand out.
- Fans will not be allowed to enter the event without a voucher. Admission prices are \$2 for students & senior citizens and \$3 for adults. We also have winter season passes available as well like we did for football season.
- Fans are encouraged to leave as soon as the contest is over through the nearest exit. We want to avoid large crowds congregating on the gym floor and in the commons.

Visiting schools on our basketball schedules at this point in time have a wide range of restrictions. We will be complying with whatever policy that school has set forth and we will pass on that information before we are set to travel to that school.
